Business Need

When Agilent was divested as a separate business entity from Hewlett Packard, Agilent was legally required to have totally separate connectivity. The two companies shared over 300 business partners. Agilent required each of their business partners to be integrated into the new Agilent backbone. The connectivity to Agilent through HP had to be broken. HP connectivity for the business partners could not be interrupted.

Solution

For each business partner, NSAi project managers and engineers reviewed network architectures and developed customer requirements and documentation. NSAi developed proposed designs and implemented approved solutions for each business partner migration. NSAi created business partner support plans and transitioned these plans to Agilent support after each successful implementation.
